

Yard Sales:

Residents are allowed 3 yard sales within a calendar year. Residents are required to purchase a permit for the yard sales. The permit is good for 2 consecutive days and must be purchased at Town Hall prior to the yard sale. Yard Sales are a rain or shine event, so permits are only good for the days issued.

Police Department Services:

Our Police Department offers several services in addition to patrolling the town. They offer a Vacation House Check which is filled out prior to being out of town and the police will stop by the house making sure it is secure throughout the time you are out of town. Also they offer an automated Elderly Check which is a phone service that calls and to ensure the elderly are ok. If the appropriate response is not received then the police will go out to the residence for a wellness check.

The Police Department Officer on duty can be contacted by calling 336-367-7828, which will forward the cellphone of the officer on duty. If you get a machine call the Yadkin County Sherriff's Office at 336-679-4217 or in an emergency call 911.

Thank you for moving to our Great Little Town. Here is some information that will help answer some of your day to day living questions within our town. If you should think of any questions please call us at 336-367-7941. Option 1 for general questions and option 4 to leave a message for our Public Works Department with issues of water or sewer.



Services: Trash/Recycle Pickup (Contracted with Waste Management)

If you are within the town limits you are provided two (2) trash bins; 1 with a green lid and 1 with a yellow lid. The green lid trash bin is for the weekly garbage pickup, which is scheduled on Tuesdays; please have the bins placed curbside by 7:00AM to ensure your garbage is picked up. The Yellow lid is for your bi-weekly recycle pickup; which is done every other Monday, and again please have placed curbside by 7:00AM. If there is an issue with pickup the town will notify you by a phone tree message and on Facebook. It is important to update Town Hall of phone number changes to ensure you receive messages.

Items such as pizza boxes are considered normal garbage, not recycle due to the grease.

Services Cont.: Bulk Item Pickup

A service also provided to those in the town limits is Bulk Item Pickup. These items would be considered items that neither fall into recycle or daily garbage. Items such as box springs and mattresses, appliances, junk items. However, due to regulations from the landfill, **TV's and computer monitors are not allowed.** Also within the category of items that are not allowed would be pallets, tires, engines, oils, paints. Bulk Item Pickup is the 3rd Monday of the month unless it is a town holiday, then bulk will be picked up on the 3rd Tuesday.

Brush Pickup:

Will consist of items you have cleaned up within your yard. Limbs, trimmed shrubbery, grass clippings, and leaves. During the summer months trimmed shrubbery, grass clippings and leaves should be placed in clear plastic bags. During the fall leaves may be lined up along the roadway so the public works department can vacuum up the leaves. At no time should leaves or others items be burned within the town limits. Please note also that if you pay someone to trim shrubbery or trees, it is that person's responsibility to take away the items. These items will be picked up on the 3rd Wednesday of each month. Again if that day should be a town holiday, then brush pickup will be done the next business day.

Please Note that Apartment Complexes have their own services for Trash, Bulk, and Brush

Pets:

Pets are allowed in the town, however dogs are required to be on a leash if being walked and when at home must be either within an enclosed fence or invisible fence area. All pets are to be current on their vaccines. Failure to produce required papers showing pets current on vaccinations if asked are subject to being fined if not corrected in a specified time.

Zoning:

If you are making changes to your property that affects the footprint of the building, adding building you must have a zoning permit prior to making such changes. This will also include pools and require that all pools have a enclosed fence around the pool area. There are setbacks to additions that must be met and you can get the additional information at Town Hall during normal business hours. For other ordinance questions please call Town Hall
