Town of Boonville October 5, 2021, Regular Meeting Minutes Harvey E. Smith Municipal Building

The following were in attendance at the 10/5/21 regular meeting: Mayor Vaughn Benton; Commissioners David Cox, Monica Craver, Dwaine Dobbins, and Tim Driver. Also in attendance were Finance Officer/Town Clerk Kim Wells, Public Works Director Jeff Jones, Police Chief Jeff Hobson, and Administrative Assistant/Zoning Officer Steve Hutchens. Town Attorney James Freeman was present via zoom. Mayor Pro-tem Justin Phillips was absent.

- I. Call to Order and Welcome: Mayor Benton called the 10/5/21 meeting to order at 6:59 p.m.
- II. Conflict of Interest Issues and Approval of Agenda: Commissioner Cox requested the agenda include the quote to Carter and Kirk Paving. Commissioner Craver motioned to accept (agenda) with that one addition. Commissioner Cox seconded, and the motion passed unanimously.
- III. Pledge of Allegiance and Prayer: Mayor Benton led the Pledge of Allegiance and the prayer.
- **IV. Adoption of minutes:** Commissioner Craver motioned to approve (the 9/7 regular session minutes) as written. Commissioner Cox seconded, and the motion passed unanimously.
- V. Public Comments: None were voiced.
- VI. Old Town Business:
 - A. American Rescue Plan (ARP) and Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Fund Projects: Commissioner Craver stated they was looking at spending some funds for park benches and maybe some equipment of the new police vehicle. Public Works Director Jones stated that he had been in contact with engineer Benji Thomas about some ARP projects. Discussion followed.
- B. Repairs to the Generator: Public Works Director Jones stated the parts were still on backorder. VII. New Town Business:
 - A. Motion to approve the following Consent Agenda items:
 - Ratify the purchase of a heat pump for the Police Department in the amount of \$4,765 to Junior Collins HVAC.
 - Ratify the contracted services of Hill's Emergency Light Sales to install equipment to new Police Vehicles in the amount of \$9,780.63 (\$7,820.63 equipment and \$1,960 labor).

Commissioner Cox motioned to ratify those two agenda items. Commissioner Craver seconded, and the motion passed unanimously.

- **B.** Proposed Budget Amendments dated 10/5/21: Finance Officer/Town Clerk Wells presented the Board with some proposed budget amendments. Commissioner Craver motioned to accept those and make those modifications. Commissioner Cox seconded and the motion passed unanimously.
- C. Paving Quote to Carter and Kirk: Discussion followed on the quote. Commissioner Craver motioned that we do appropriate patches, if Powell funds come in within one week (of the meeting), do paving on Marin Ave instead of patching. Commissioner Cox seconded, and the motion passed unanimously. It was Board consensus to pay patches with Enterprise funds.

VIII. Reports and announcements:

- A. Mayor's report: Mayor Benton asked Zoning Officer Hutchens about 130 Howard Ave. Mr. Hutchens stated he had been in contact with Attorney Freeman. Commissioner Craver stated that the attorney had sent a nuisance ordinance from Elkin and suggested that Boonville use that to fit our town. She stated the nuisance ordinance gave the town more options than our current one. Mayor Benton asked about the new meters. Public Works Director Jones stated that 300 had been changed out and 468 on the way that was on national recall. He stated the department had manually read 100 meters this last billing.
 - Mayor Benton asked about the proposed ordinances. Police Chief Hobson stated he was still working with Attorney Freeman on them.
- **B. Finance Officer's report:** Finance Officer/Town Clerk Wells stated that Charles Scott had finished with the workpapers for the audit and had submitted them to Gibson and Company. She reviewed the budget vs actual report. Administrative Assistant/Zoning Officer Hutchens had nothing to report.

- C. Public Works Director's report: Public Works Director Jones stated he had been in discussion with DOT about the bridge on Holly Street. He stated the fire hydrant damaged by an accident had been replaced. He informed the Board that he had sent them appraisals from DOT about the intersection project. This was to purchase a right-a-away in the towns grass parking lot. Mr. Jones stated that all GovDeal items had sold.
- **D.** Police Chief's report: Police Chief Hobson reported they was fully staffed. He thanked the Board for getting the Police Departments AC fixed. He stated the truck was at the vendors location getting the equipment installed. Police Chief Hobson updated the Board on the Governors Hwy Safety points and items they could get through the program.
- E. Fire Department Report: Assistant Fire Chief Josh Crump reviewed the statistics of the Fire Department and reported on other items going on within the Fire Department.
- F. Departmental Commissioner's Reports:

 Commissioner Craver spoke of the new game room and other zoning items that will be needing closer attention too. She stated the bathroom at Public Works had outside water running in and that it would cost \$2,200 for gutters on the backside of the building. She stated the quote to also add ruff and siding for the shop would cost around \$49,000. Commissioner Craver stated the road going into Public Works had flooding issues and needed to be addressed. She stated the estimated cost was \$7,700 to fix and that quote did not include a culvert. She then updated the Board on Yadtel and their grant to get fiber to Boonville.

 No other Commissioners gave a report.
- **G.** Committee reports as needed: BBDDA President, Kristen Johnson reported on upcoming events. She stated the Deweys Holiday store fundraiser would be used to purchase swings and climbing equipment for the town park.
- IX. Closed Session per NCGS 143-318.11(a)(6) Personnel: Commissioner Craver motioned to go into closed session per NCGS 143-318.11(a) (6) for personnel. Commissioner Cox seconded, and the motioned passed unanimously at 7:57 p.m.
 - Commissioner Craver motioned to return to open session. Commissioner Cox seconded, and the motioned passed unanimously at 9:00 p.m.
 - Commissioner Driver motioned that we accept Jeff Jone's resignation as of tonight. Commissioner Dobbins seconded, and the motion passed unanimously.
- **X. Adjourn:** Commissioner Craver motioned to adjourn. Commissioner Cox seconded, and the motion passed unanimously. The meeting ended at 9:03 p.m.


