A letter from your Public Works Director

Dear Boonville Residents,

Work continues to progress on our water and sewer projects. The Hurt Creek Outfall project is 50% complete. Within the next month, the new piping portion of the project should be completed. Upgrades to the waste water treatment plant, our second project, are scheduled to begin next month. A preconstruction meeting will be held with the contractor on January 24 to set the schedule. Our third project, the looping of water lines on Kerr and Oakland, has began the week of January 16.

As our FY 2016-2017 budget year comes to an end, you can be assured that we have made progress in improving the infrastructure for the Town of Boonville. We look forward to continuing this trend in future years and will keep you updated on our projects' status.
