I understand that deposits are required for all water connections and that these funds will remain with my account until my services are disconnected. At that time, I know any balances will be removed from my deposit and any remaining funds will be mailed to me at my new mailing address. I understand that the Town requires garbage pickup for inside limit customers. I understand that all charges on the account are my responsibility until paid in full. I understand that utility bills are due no later than 5:00pm on the last day of the month. If not paid by this timeframe, I understand there is a 10% late fee assigned to my account and that if not paid by 5:00pm on the 14th of the month, an additional fee of \$30.00 will be assessed and my services will be disconnected on the 15th. I understand that I will be liable for any fee or charge assessed to this account for unlawfully tampering with and/or damage to the service lines/meter owned by the Town of Boonville. I understand that I am responsible for all charges/usage on this service address until I notify the Town of Boonville that I am moving and wish to have services disconnected. Providing your social security number is voluntary and utility services cannot be withheld because of failure to provide it. The Town may use this number to aid in the collecting of: delinquent public enterprise utility debts, property taxes, town licenses/permits. The collecting methods will include using the state's debt set-off program under G.S. Ch. 105A. I understand that providing my email address will give the Town of Boonville permission to send utility bills, late notices, or any other town notifications to my personal email address. I understand that the Town of Boonville is not responsible for lost utility bills through the US Postal Service nor emails that were not delivered because of SPAM settings.
